# Leaning Tower Of Ellisburg...

In the last issue of the Farmer we featured a collapsing silo. In this issue we picture a silo that was on its way to disaster, when workmen from Woodford Brothers. Contractors from Syracuse, erected braces and guy cables to save it. Farm owner John Eastman, Ellisburg, said this week quick action was the saving force. As soon as it was discovered that the silo was tilting, fire departments responded and a friend brought in heavy construction equipment so the cables could be anchored as soon as workers arrived. About 25 cables were attached to the silo, containing 1,000 tons of silage, and it was stabilized about 20 hours after it had begun tilting toward the center of the barn. The silo will be dismantled after the silage has been removed.




### Slipping Silo





From the top of an Otisco Fire Truck ladder, Rick Woodford of Woodford Brothers Inc. straps a support cable onto a 70-foot-high silo that threatened to topple Tuesday night at the Goodrich Farms in Fabius. Fabius Fire Chief William DeHart said the concrete base of the silo had deteriorated, causing it to lean. Woodford Brothers were able to stabilize the silo - which was moving at a rate of one inch per hour - at 2:30 a.m. Wednesday. Workers spent most of Wednesday working on the structure.
