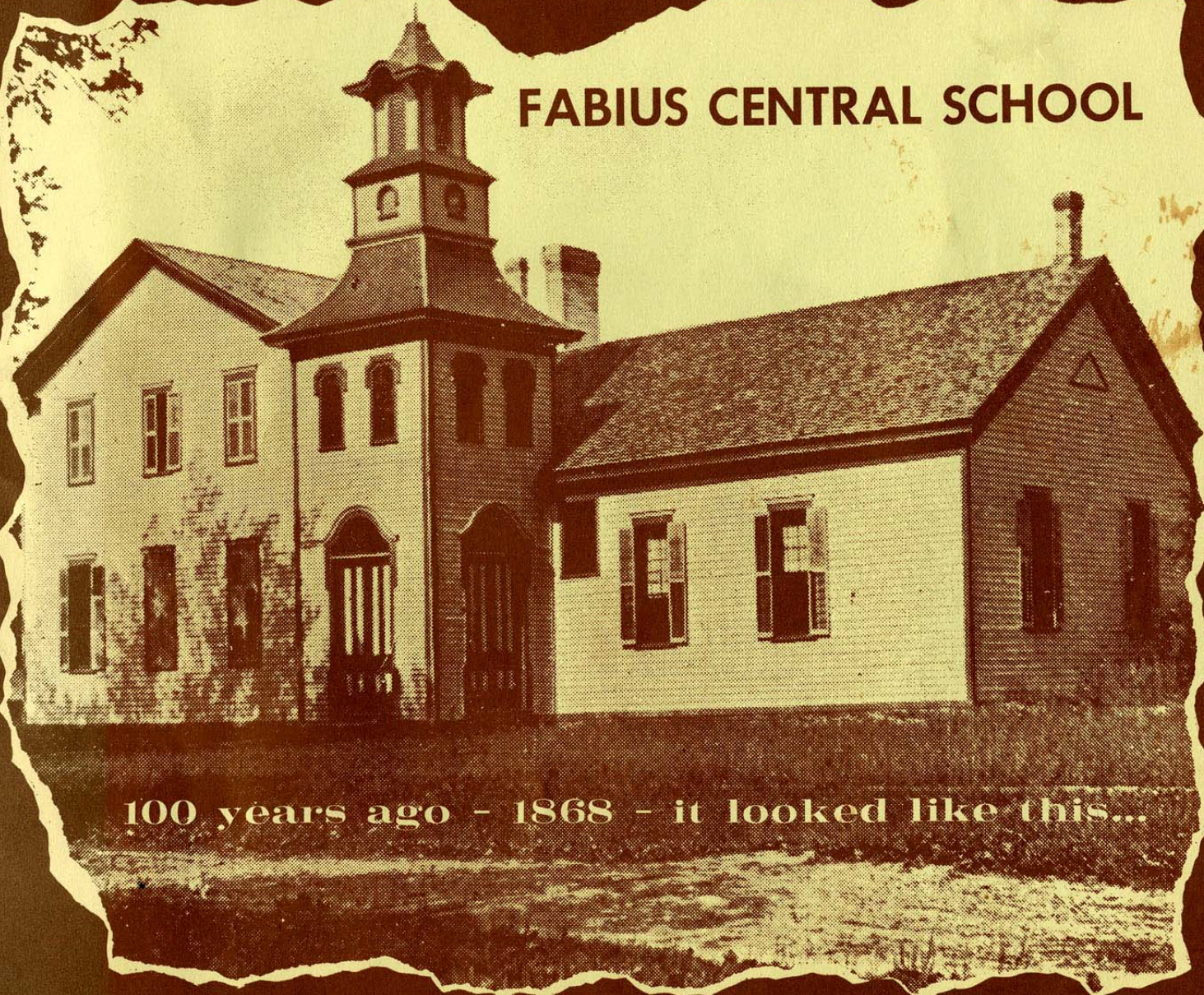

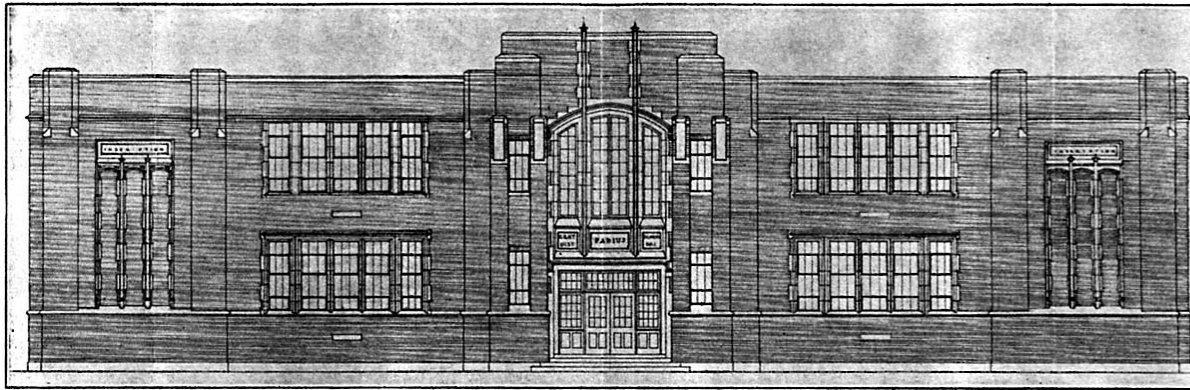

for this proposed building have been prepared under the regulations of the State Department of School Buildings and the proposed site and building have both received approval from the State Department of Education.

Plans call for a building approximately 133 feet front, 100 feet rear and having a basement and two stories.

By advantage of the slope of ground, the building of two and three stories at front will be three full stories in the rear. Basement will be used for storage but toward rear contains the gym floor, girls and boys lockers and showers, shop, garage, boiler room and cafeteria, boiler room, coal, etc.

On first floor will be found six standard grade rooms, one of which is especially fitted out for the beginners. Also there we find the Teacher and Health rooms, Boys' and Girls' Toilets, the roof of the gymnasium and bleachers for 300 spectators.

On the second floor we find a study room, library, science laboratory, drawing room, cooking laboratory, home arts room, four class rooms and boys' and girls' toilets. On this floor, one flight up from the front entrance, is to be found an auditorium to seat 475, with a stage well equipped with footlights, border lights, curtain, cyclorama, etc. There are three exits from the auditorium to the ground. A movie booth is to be provided large enough for commercial machines. The entire building is to be of Class A or fire resisting construction and will be heated with steam and ventilated by the modern unit system. Plumbing and electrical work will all be placed according to State requirements and of the best material and workmanship.

This building, while primarily for school uses, is also planned with thought of being a Community Center, and will be enjoyed by the whole District parentage as well as by the children. This building will give Fabius and Associated Districts a schoolhouse second to none of the New York State Central Schools.

## PROPOSED ANNUAL PAYMENTS

Annual payments to retire Bonds are suggested below so as to keep the tax rate fairly uniform throughout the 30-year period. Note that payments upon principal for the first two years are to be omitted; also note that of the payments shown the State will pay its proportionate share.
