















Two Guns and Shot Ready for Scrap Pile



Food for the arsenal of victory. Michael G. Shea, captain of the scrap drive in Fabius, and E. H. Rowley, mayor of the village of Fabius, stand at one of the two cannon being donated to the scrap drive. The two guns, 42-pounders, are

dated 1829 and 1833, respectively, and saw service on American ships of the line. Also slated for the melting pot are 40 cannon balls, heaviest of which weighs 63 pounds. All told, the Fabius donation is expected to yield between eight and 10 tons of metal.
